My Pink World is a relationship comedy aimed towards a 7-11 audience with a girl pull. The series features little blonde ten-year-old Tiffany, who on the weekend goes to stay with her dad Mike, a single car-mechanic living a bachelor lifestyle in a dingy two-bedroom apartment. Every Friday, two worlds collide... The package is 52 x 11 minutes.

SuperZeroes is a comedy adventure series with a target audience of 7-11. On planet Heroica, super heroes are born, bread and sent out into the galaxy to defend against evil. It's a natural part of life and there is no greater honor than graduating Heroica Academy and getting a Super Hero License. Unfortunately, not every Heroica citizen has high-profile and quality powers, no matter how deep they search within themselves. In fact, for every genuine hero there are a dozen of desperate wannabe-heroes. But now, they are making a stand, to be recognized as the superhero(challenged) individuals they are! The package is intended 26 x 22 minutes.
